


Emergency Alert & Notification Systems



BE INFORMED – STAY INFORMED

If we can't reach you, we can't alert you!



- SUBSCRIBE to receive emergency alerts, notifications and updates via e-mail, text and phone where you live, work and play.
- MONITOR local radio and news channels for official information, instructions and updates.
- ENCOURAGE friends, family, neighbors and coworkers to subscribe.

To help recover after a disaster: Make copies or digital records of your important documents Take photos or video of your home and its contents Store the copies in two different locations

Evacuation



Your Evacuation Plan:

- Plan more than one place to go.
- Map two routes by car and two routes on foot.
- What will you take? Where is it located?
- Plan for pets & service animals.
- Keep your gas tank at least half full.

Fire Near Your Home



Prepare to Evacuate

- Listen to radio/TV emergency alerts and first responders
- Map safe escape routes
- Assemble irreplaceable possessions
- Confine pets for quick departure
- Do not delay leave when instructed to do so
