

WINTER CAR CARE TIPS:



- Make sure you have a minimum of 4mm of tread on your tires. This will provide adequate traction in the wet. Consider purchasing new tires.
- Check your tire pressure. Your tires are likely underinflated, as a drop of 10 degrees lowers your tire pressure by 1.5 PSI.
- Maintain a clear windshield. Replace wipers and polish the glass for a super clean your windshield.
- If you park your car outside, wax, seal or ceramic coat your paint. This will help keep it clean. (*Pro Tip: wax, seal, or coat your windshield too.*)
- Use rubber floor mats to protect your carpet.
- Check your spare tire to make sure it is inflated and in good condition.
- Make sure your tire repair tools are in good condition (*inflatable slime, air pump, jack, lug nut wrench, etc.*).
- Make sure you know how to repair a flat, or know who to call if you have a break-down.
- Check your battery, as batteries don't get along with cold weather!
